

Streetsboro Education Association Scholarship (2017-2018)

Scholarship Purpose:

The purpose of this scholarship is to assist a deserving graduating senior of SHS with school expenses as he/she continues his/her education.

Eligibility:

The scholarship is open to a graduating senior from SHS, with at least a 2.5 GPA, who has definite plans to continue studying in some form of an educational setting beyond high school (college, trade school, etc.).

Applicant Requirements:

1. Two letters of recommendation - one from a staff person of the Streetsboro School System (teacher, guidance counselor, administrator) and a second letter from a person in the community (a non-relative) who can attest to the character and educational interests of the applicant.
2. Official high school transcript. (Must indicate course work completed, GPA, class rank, and SAT/ACT scores.)
3. 750-1,000 word essay on the prompt below:
“All of us have had a teacher who has made a profound difference in our lives—someone who changed our lives, made us think more deeply, set our feet on the right path. Perhaps it was a teacher we met in a classroom, but it could just have easily been a coach, a youth group leader, a family or community elder, or religious leader. In your essay, write a tribute to such a teacher, someone who has taught them an important lesson that they still remember.”

Scholarship Amount:

Two scholarships for \$500 will be awarded. Money will be distributed to winners after proof of tuition payments have been submitted to the SEA treasurer.

Application Deadline:

Strength of References- 5 pts

Strength of Extra-curricular activity, community service, etc.- 5pts

Essay

- Address prompt- identify the person, relationship, and lesson learned -20 pts
